



# Anderson Elementary School

Anderson Elementary is designed as a four section school for grades K-5. The grade levels are divided into two wings: a “primary” wing for kindergarten through second grade and an “intermediate” wing which houses third through fifth grades. A centralized extra “swing” classroom provides flexibility in managing class size each year. The classroom wings are divided by the central core which contains the media center, administration area, Large Group Instruction (LGI) room, volunteer center, gymnasium, kitchen/cafeteria and the main mechanical support spaces. A stage/platform is located between the LGI and the gymnasium and includes moveable partitions which can be opened to either space individually or both at the same time. Corridor “spokes” connect the classroom wings with the central core. Two computer education labs and classrooms for preschool, special education, academic advancement, English as a second language, speech, art and special projects programs are located along these corridor connectors.
