Blackford County Schools, located in Hartford City, Indiana renovated and made additions to a K-2 elementary school and a 3-5 elementary school. Both Schools received upgrading of existing finishes and building systems as well as significant new construction. New work included grade level classrooms, media center, multipurpose room, administrative offices and kitchen. Site improvements such as student drop-off areas, parking and play areas were also included.
