Brookville Middle School is designed for an optimum enrollment of 600 students in grades five through eight. The two story brick classroom section creates a compact building form; it minimized the cost of site development and allowed for future growth. The architectural design follows the existing contours of the land. The result is a building that bends around the southeast side of the site, providing clear definition of the academic spaces and public spaces while creating an inviting main entry. The facility includes special education classrooms, computer labs, science rooms, teacher prep space, art rooms with a kiln, music rooms, home economics lab, industrial arts lab, media center, administration area, PE gymnasium with team locker rooms, and a kitchen/cafeteria.
