



Butler Bowl Butler University Indianapolis, IN

The Butler University football stadium grandstand seating and press box project consists of a 5,000-seat grandstand with a 500-seat visitor seating section and a 4,130 sqft multilevel press box inclusive of a hospitality viewing deck. The project also includes associated site amenities. The press box design features a celebratory ornamental structural steel arch which proudly bears the university's name and bulldog icon. The brick façade incorporates a series of quoins which project slightly above the parapet of the hospitality deck level. A stone string course encircles the building and knits together the first and second story levels. Brick site walls with cast stone coping help tie the new stadium structure to the surrounding buildings and site.
