The Chi Omega Sorority addition/renovation included 67 new beds and expanded functions including study areas, an art room, bike storage area, new mailroom, laundry facilities and officers board room. A new recreation room opens onto a courtyard with landscaping and privacy fencing. Limestone ashlar veneer with siding were used to blend with the existing stone veneer. New energy efficient windows were installed. Security concerns were also addressed with building access control, security lighting and open sight lines. Parking capacity was increased as well as new landscaping.
