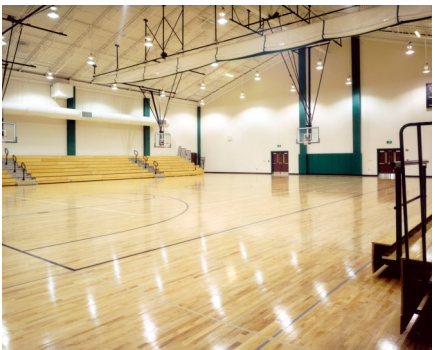




**Cloverdale Middle School**  
Cloverdale, IN

Cloverdale Middle School houses grades five through eight and has a maximum enrollment of 600 students. Divided into corridors for team teaching, the centrally located media center serves as an important resource to students. The activity area is situated between the main entry and existing elementary school. It includes administration, art, industrial technology, music and the gymnasium. The cafeteria/kitchen serves the neighboring elementary school. Particular attention was paid to scale so that the new middle school did not overpower the elementary school and each maintained its identity.
