The educational specifications for this school focused on grade-level houses, each composed of four classrooms surrounding a commons area and a teacher resource room for each house. The “house” concept allows students to be served by the entire grade-level staff in three different learning environments. The building is divided into main components. The singular spaces, such as administration, severely and profoundly handicapped student classrooms, art, music, gym, cafeteria, and kitchen, are one component. The west end serves as the neighborhood of houses, with the focus of the neighborhood being a new media center coupled with a project room. To encourage reading and the exploration of new technology the media room has a full height glass wall off the main corridor to showcase the activities within.
