


Ferguson Academic Building Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana Bloomington, IN

The Ivy Tech academic building features a two story glass entry lobby which leads to student services, administrative offices, and two classroom wings. Other support areas include data processing, a library, bookstore, student commons, and student and faculty lounges. The facility is designed to accommodate 2,000 students for both day and evening classes that are offered throughout the week and on the weekend. Located on a 27 acre site, which affords room available for a planned future 60,000 square foot expansion. Parking is provided for 500 cars with space to add 400 when the building is expanded.
