Highland High School completed improvements to both its indoor and outdoor athletic facilities. OMS designed a 400 meter, blue latex surface track for a cost of approximately \$150,000. The school also elected to add five tennis courts to the facility for a total of 10. The cost of this project totaled approximately \$190,000.

As part of a complete renovation, OMS also designed a six lane swimming pool with movable bulkhead and two diving boards, raised officials scoring area, pool locker rooms, and second floor spectator balcony. The swimming pool addition was nestled between the existing Senior High School and Junior High School buildings and features natural daylighting of the pool. To allow public access, separate vestibules were provided to secure the pool from the remainder of the building.
