



Huntingburg and Holland Elementary Schools

Huntingburg, IN

OMS developed a common program for two different local community schools with greatly different student populations at Huntingburg and Holland Elementary Schools. The resulting facilities are both single story serving grades K-5. Both schools have special education, art, music, computer labs and physical education program spaces, along with a media center and administrative areas. Classrooms are organized around an academic commons area consisting of support functions including remediation rooms, a staff prep room and restrooms. This design maximizes the efficiency of day to day operations and allows air handling equipment to be housed in a mezzanine above each commons area for each classroom wing. Huntingburg Elementary was designed as a “school -within-a-school” concept two classroom wings allowing flexible grade level groupings and grade level separation. The gymnasium accommodates two classes simultaneously and also serves as an auxiliary gymnasium for the local high school.
