

The addition/renovation of Jimtown High School accommodates growth and improvements in the high school curriculum. A new 1,000 seat auditorium with capacity for 1,000 includes a stage with full fly and orchestra pit, dressing rooms and scene shops. The new lobby with elevated ceilings and clerestory light serves the auditorium from the main corridor. A new 6,800 square feet media center and new classrooms also were completed. Other improvements include renovations to the main lobby, administration area and cafeteria. A new multipurpose room, student lockers, renovations to boys and girls restrooms, and a new weight room also were designed. Planned site improvements provided for a reorganization of bus and vehicle drop off at the main entrance and a new service drive at rear of the property.
