


IU Law Library underwent an expansion and upgrade that was completed in two phases. Phase I consisted of an addition including five floors that dovetail with the existing structure and overlap it at the upper levels. The expansion houses over 300,000 volumes, office space, courtroom laboratories and conference rooms. Phase II included a renovation to make narrow class and lecture rooms more versatile and to provide for faculty offices. OMS worked with Indiana University to complete programming, architecture and interiors for the project.
