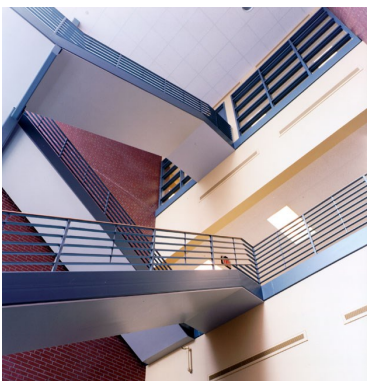


Lilly Hall & Martin Hall

Lilly Hall science facility underwent a renovation that addressed the building's infrastructure, including a new HVAC system and electrical service. The 1,500 sqft addition houses a boiler room that accommodates both the existing and new facilities.

The new Martin Hall houses the School of Nursing, occupational therapy and physical therapy programs. The building consists of double-loaded corridors with life science lab spaces opposite administrative office and support spaces. The massing and exterior materials of the hall complement the adjacent existing facility and the campus aesthetic. A new boiler room addition accommodates both the existing and new facilities.
