



Maple Grove Elementary School

Maple Grove Elementary is designed for an enrollment of 600 students in kindergarten through fifth grade. A primary and intermediate wing are organized around two outdoor sculptural courtyards. The intermediate wing includes science, music and art classrooms. The central core of the building houses common functions such as administration, the media center, special education, Title I, speech/hearing, testing and small group instruction. The gymnasium seats 250. Large group instruction room (LGI), and cafeteria are separated from the academic wings to facilitate after hours community use. The LGI has a folding partition wall that can be opened to the cafeteria while a platform stage opens to the gym. The facility was designed to receive a second identical elementary school of 600 student capacity in the future when enrollments grow. To maximize savings, the kitchen and mechanical room are sized to meet the needs of both schools.
