The Mary Feeser Elementary School project consisted of renovations to the existing facility as well as additions, including general classrooms, a media center, and cafeteria. The renovations to the administration area incorporated both a bright primary and a pastel color scheme, which gives an inviting, look throughout, and emphasizes a sense of identity. Located between the administration office and one of the facility's main hallways, is a working tower clock which serves as a wayfinding element to the younger students. The new media center is designed with a barrel-vaulted ceiling accented by several whimsical windows of varying shapes and sizes. An abundance of natural lighting reinforces the playful nature of the overall design.
