



Noble Crossing Elementary School

Noblesville, IN

The 700-student capacity K-4 school was designed in a unique key-shaped design similar to a previous “prototype” school White River Elementary School (also in Noblesville). The building is arranged around three wings: administrative, community and academic. While the administrative wing is home to the reception of students, parents and visitors, the academic wing features a state-of-the-art media center which serves as the hub for 30 classrooms. The community wing features a cafeteria supported by a full-service kitchen, an elevated stage area, large group instruction (LGI) room and a movable wall that separates the stage/LGI from the gym and cafeteria. An outside courtyard, located between the classrooms and media center, features accessibility to and from the media center as well as to corridors leading to classrooms.
