

North Davies Elementary School

Elnora, IN

This K-6 school is designed for 708 students using prime time enrollment criteria. It includes 6 kindergarten classrooms, twenty-eight classrooms for grades 1-6, 3 special education rooms, computer labs, an art room, a science room, 2 music rooms for band and choral, a media center, an administration area, a PE gymnasium, large group room and cafeteria with full service kitchen and serving area. A Large Group Instruction (LGI) area with a stage; designed to seat a minimum of one full grade level, serves as a gathering place for presentations, speakers, and mini-concerts. A movable wall separates the LGI area from the gymnasium. Each classroom is designed with, a tackable wall surface area for visual displays and individual student storage areas. The site encompasses approximately 20 acres and is adjacent to the existing Junior/Senior high school including a 75-space faculty/visitor parking area located near the main entrance with a separate 22-bus parking area located in the back of the school to improve site traffic flow and security. Multiple access points into the school are available with walks provided to encourage students to walk to school.
