

Thompson Crossing Elementary is a 102,000 square foot facility for students in kindergarten through fourth grade. Designed around a key shaped plan arrangement the classrooms surround a central media center. Playground space is provided at the south side of the building for first through fourth grade, and a separate fenced kindergarten play area is located on the east side adjacent to the kindergarten classrooms. The public areas including gymnasium, Large Group Instruction room and cafeteria are flexible and can be combined for large events. A safe and secure main entry welcomes visitors to the school.
