A design-build project, Phase I consisted of new construction on 12 acres of an 86 acre property. The main structure included a regulation high school gymnasium, boys and girls locker rooms, two classrooms with dual usage as dining, an administration area, and storage and mechanical equipment spaces. Phase II involved new construction of a two story, 45,000 square foot academic building with general purpose classrooms and administrative offices. The scope also includes a 3,100 s.f. addition to the gymnasium and two new parking lots.
