



Monroe County Courthouse Bloomington IN

The original stone structure was constructed in 1908 at a cost of \$188,000. The fish shaped weathervane was used from the 1826 courthouse. This project involved the historical renovation of all of the public access spaces and the exterior of the building. Courthouse offices were renovated and technology upgrades were installed. A window replacement program, HVAC improvements, life safety/code updates, total site development and landscaping were also accomplished during this project.
