This new five-level, 126,000 sqft building is a collaborative city-county multiuse facility. The design includes 124 bed jail with the necessary ancillary services for food preparation and storage; a law enforcement headquarters, seven courts with judges chambers and support offices, offices for the county attorneys and their support offices; county clerks offices with support spaces; and a county-wide communication system.
