

Orange County Courthouse

Paoli, IN

This structure is one of the two oldest continuously occupied courthouses in the State of Indiana having been completed in 1850 at a cost of \$14,000. It was designed in the Greek Revival style popular at its time of construction with a Doric portico supported by six fluted columns. The scope of the project included a complete architectural, mechanical, electrical and plumbing renovation to this historic landmark courthouse.
