



Bloomington City Hall and Showers Building Bloomington, IN

OMS worked with Bloomington Advancement Corporation to renovate and restore a 200,000 square foot furniture factory. The building houses Bloomington City Hall, Indiana University’s research park, and private office space. A challenge was to find common ground among the owner groups while meeting their individual design, funding, scheduling and project coordination concerns. The facility provides each owner with an identifiable entry while housing ceremonial and office space for the city. Landscape architecture included the design of a plaza, selection of site furniture and a planting plan.
